SUBJECT: Job 061613 FAP NHPP-0043(37) I-40 Strs. & Apprs. (Hwys. 13 & 31) (S) Route 31, Section 3 Route 13, Section 10 Lonoke County Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion

After appropriate environmental review, it has been determined that the subject job is a Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion as described by the ARDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement on Categorical Exclusion Documentation and Processing. A public hearing will not be offered for this project.

The purpose of this project is to replace two overpass bridge structures over I-40 in Lonoke County. The bridge on Highway 31 (Str. 030228) and the bridge on Highway 13 (Str. 03655) both have a deck condition rating of "Poor". The total project length is 0.73 mile. A project location map is attached.

The existing Highway 31 roadway consists of two 12' wide paved travel lanes with 4' wide paved shoulders. Proposed improvements include two 12' wide paved travel lanes, one 12' wide center turn lane, and concrete curb and gutters. In addition, a 5' wide concrete sidewalk separated by a 3' wide grass berm will be constructed along the west side of the roadway transitioning to a 6.5' concrete sidewalk across the bridge. A 10' wide concrete shared use path (SUP) separated by a 6' grass berm will be constructed along the concrete SUP across the bridge. The SUP will be separated by a parapet wall for pedestrian protection.

The existing Highway 13 roadway consists of two 10' wide paved travel lanes with 4' wide paved shoulders. Proposed improvements include two 14' paved travel lanes with concrete curb and gutters.

Both bridge replacements will be constructed on new location adjacent to the existing bridges and designed for future widening of I-40. Approximately 0.28 acre of additional right of way will be required for this project.

Design data for this project is as follows:

The project will not involve relocations, underground storage tanks, hazardous materials, floodplains, farmland, any environmental justice issues, or cultural resources. This project has been determined to generate minimal air quality impacts for Clean Air Act criteria pollutants and has not been linked with any special mobile source air toxic concerns. The State Historic Preservation Officer's clearance is attached.

Based on the ARDOT noise policy, a noise analysis is not required for this project. The bridge replacements do not involve adding capacity or exposing noise sensitive land uses to traffic noise sources. In compliance with federal guidelines, local authorities will not require notification.

The official species list obtained from the US Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) Information for Planning and Consultation identified the following species as potentially occurring within the project boundaries: Eastern Black Rail (*Laterallus jamaicensis ssp. jamaicensis*), Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*), Red Knot (*Calidris canutus rufa*), and the monarch butterfly (*Danaus plexippus*). The official species list is attached. It has been determined that this project will have "no effect" on the listed species due to the lack of habitat and distance to known species occurrences.

The monarch butterfly is a candidate species and as such is not federally protected under the Endangered Species Act. However, the USFWS recommends agencies Job 061613 Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion Page 3 of 3

implement conservation measures for candidate species in action areas as these are species, by definition, that may warrant future protection under the Act. ARDOT will plant native wildflowers after construction as a conservation measure.


This project will not have a discharge of dredged or fill material into waters of the United States, therefore Section 404 permit will not be required.

The staff of the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program (AHPP) reviewed the project identification form for the above referenced undertaking in Lonoke County, Arkansas in Section 17, Township 2 North, Range 8 West and Section 15, Township 2 North, Range 7 West. The proposed undertaking entails the replacement of two bridges (ARDOT Bridge Numbers 03228 and 03655) on Highways 13 and 31 over Interstate 40. Minor amounts of right-of-way will be needed for Bridge 03228, consisting of 0.28 acres and no additional right-of-way is needed for Bridge 03655. A total of three shovel tests were excavated in the area of potential effect (APE), all of which were negative for cultural material.

An architectural resources review was conducted of the bridges, which are considered to be not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP).

Based on the provided information, the AHPP concurs with the finding of **no historic properties affected pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.4(d)(1)** for the proposed undertaking and that no further archeological work is needed. We also concur that bridges 03228 and 03655 are not eligible for inclusion in the NRHP.

Tribes that have expressed an interest in the area include the Cherokee Nation, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Jena Band of Choctaw Indians, the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, the Osage Nation, the Quapaw Nation, and the Shawnee Tribe. We recommend consultation in accordance with 36 CFR § 800.2(c)(2).

- A Public Service Announcement ran in Cumulus Media-KOKY 102.1 FM and EZ Spanish Media-LaZeta 106.3 FM from Monday, December 6, 2021 through Thursday, December 9, 2021.
- Letters were mailed to Public Officials on November 24, 2021.
- Minority Minister Letters were mailed on November 24, 2021.
- Flyers mailed to citizens.

A listing of general comments concerning the proposed project follows:

- There are multiple pedestrians relying on the Highway 31 bridge to get to and from work every day. The Shared Use Path will provide much needed protection for those individuals.
- Suggestion that decorative stamped concrete on the bridge structures would be nice.
- Many farmers are in the area and use this bridge to cross; however, the current bridges are too narrow to cross safely. Please make these bridges wide enough to accommodate 20 ft or larger modern farming equipment.
- Supports the proposed project especially since the bridge structures will be safer and constructed with current design standards.


