Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion

After appropriate environmental review, it has been determined that the subject iob is a Tier 1 Categorical Exclusion as described by the ARDOT/FHWA Programmatic Agreement on Categorical Exclusion Documentation and Processing. A public hearing will not be offered for this project.

The purpose of this project is to replace bridge M0779 on Highway 34 over an unnamed drainage in Greene County due to its poor condition. Total project length is 0.05 mile. A project location map is attached.

The existing Highway 34 roadway consist of two 10' wide paved travel lanes with 4' wide unpaved shoulders. The existing right of way width is between 80' - 105'.

Proposed improvements include two 11' wide paved travel lanes with 4' (2' paved) wide shoulders. Proposed right of way width will be between 80' - 215'. The bridge will be replaced on existing location with a temporary one lane detour built along the north side of the structure. Approximately 0.65 acre of additional right of way and 0.12 acre of temporary construction easement will be required for this project. Of this acreage, approximately 0.65 acre of important farmland will be impacted. Form NRCS-CPA-106 is attached for the farmland impacts.

Design data for this project is as follows:

The project will not involve relocations, underground storage tanks/hazardous materials, floodplains, any environmental justice issues, or cultural resources. This project has been determined to generate minimal air quality impacts for Clean Air Act criteria pollutants and has not been linked with any special mobile source air toxic concerns. The State Historic Preservation Officer's clearance is attached.

Based on the ARDOT noise policy, a noise analysis is not required for this project. Replacing the bridge with a box culvert will not involve adding capacity, substantially changing the roadway alignment, or exposing noise sensitive land uses to traffic noise sources. In compliance with federal guidelines, local authorities will not require notification.

The official species list obtained through US Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) Information for Planning and Consultation website identifies the following federally listed species as having the potential to occur in the project area: Indiana bat (*Myotis sodalist*), pondberry (*Lindera melissifolia*), Eastern Black Rail (*Laterallus jamaicensis ssp. jamaicensis*), Piping Plover (*Charadrius melodus*), Red Knot (*Calidris canutus rufa*), and the monarch butterfly (*Danaus plexippus*).

Due to the lack of suitable habitat, it has been determined that the project will have "no effect" on the listed bird species and pondberry. Following the Programmatic Biological Opinion, it has been determined that the project will have "no effect" on the Indiana bat.

The monarch butterfly is a candidate species and as such is not federally protected under the Endangered Species Act. However, the USFWS recommends agencies implement conservation measures for candidate species in action areas as these are species, by definition, that may warrant future protection under the Act. ARDOT will plant native wildflowers after construction as a conservation measure.

Permanent stream impacts are estimated at less than 300' and less than 0.1 acre. Construction should be allowed under the terms of a Section 404 Nationwide Permit 14 for Linear Transportation Projects as defined in Federal Register 82 (4): 1860-2008. A pre-construction notification should not be required.

A Phase I Virtual Public Involvement meeting will be held at a later date. The project design will be made available to the public for two weeks and comments will be accepted.



The staff of the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program (AHPP) reviewed the submission for the above referenced undertaking in Greene County, Arkansas in Section 21, Township 18 North, Range 6 East. The proposed undertaking entails the replacement of ARDOT Bridge M0779 on Highway 34. The bridge will be replaced on the existing centerline. The proposed right-of-way and the temporary construction easement will encompass a total survey area of 0.21 acres.

An architectural resources survey determined ARDOT Bridge No. M0779 is not eligible for inclusion in the National Register of Historic Places (NRHP) (AHPP Tracking Number 109317). A total of four shovel tests were excavated in each quadrant of the APE, all of which were negative for cultural materials.

Based on the provided information, the AHPP concurs with the finding of **no historic properties affected pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.4(d)(1)** for the proposed undertaking and that no further archeological work is needed.

Tribes that have expressed an interest in the area include the Cherokee Nation, the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, the Jena Band of Choctaw Indians, the Muscogee (Creek) Nation, the Osage Nation, the Quapaw Nation, and the Shawnee Tribe. We recommend consultation in accordance with 36 CFR § 800.2(c)(2).
