WHEREAS, a thorough bid review and analysis is undertaken by the Department to ensure that only those projects are awarded which are judged to be in the best interests of the State; and

WHEREAS, the right is retained to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, or to advertise for new proposals, also as judged to be in the best public interests of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to expedite work on these important projects; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Amendment 42 of the Arkansas Constitution, Section 6, as well as other laws of this State, the Commission has the authority to delegate certain powers to the Director of Highways and Transportation.

NOW THEREFORE, upon the contractors furnishing the necessary performance and payment bonds and submitting all additional information required for the above mentioned projects, the Director is hereby authorized to enter into contracts and supplemental agreements for any projects deemed to be in the best interests of the State.

FURTHERMORE, the Director is authorized to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, and/or to advertise for new proposals whenever deemed to be in the best interests of the State.

Chairman Schueck opened the meeting at 9:30 am.

Vice Chairman Robert Moore moved, Commissioner Alec Farmer seconded and the motion passed to approve the Minutes from the previous Commission Meeting of May 1, 2019.

Vice Chairman Robert S. Moore, Jr. moved, Commissioner Alec Farmer seconded and the motion passed to have the Director write a letter to ask the U.S. Fish and Wildlife Service if they are willing to consider reevaluating the Compatibility Determination regarding the U.S. Highway 79 Bridge at Clarendon.

Commissioner Alec Farmer moved, Vice Chairman Robert S. Moore, Jr. seconded and the motion passed to approve the 2019-2020 Operating Budget, as presented by Director Bennett, which included the following:

Vice Chairman Robert S. Moore, Jr. moved, Commissioner Alec Farmer seconded and the motion passed to enter into Executive Session at 11:25 a.m. to conduct an annual review of Director Scott Bennett's employment.

MOTION

Commissioner Alec Farmer moved, Commissioner Philip Taldo seconded and the motion passed to close Executive Session and reopen the public Commission Meeting at 12:45 p.m. Chairman Tom Schueck made brief remarks that the Commission was satisfied with Director Bennett's performance. No formal action was taken.

OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS

Director Bennett presented the Commission with three options for the Governor's Long-Term Highway Funding Plan. He shared the benefits from the \$300 million per year along with explanations of each option. After discussion the Commission passed a motion to adopt Option 2. (See Motion above). After reconvening from Executive Session, the Staff presented the Commission with a draft map of the Option 2 potential projects which would provide a framework to take to the voters.

Director Bennett presented a list of upcoming meetings and events that the Commissioners and Director will be attending, including the Statewide ROADeo Finals on July 11, 2019.

Director Bennett ended the meeting with a briefing to the Commission on the historic flooding that has occurred around the state.
