Sealed bids for DEAN'S TRAIL-PHASE 2 to be constructed for the City of Springdale, Arkansas will be received online in the QuestCDN online bid interface until 2:00 P.M., TUESDAY, May 25, 2021 at which time the bids shall be publicly opened and read aloud via Zoom meeting. Zoom meeting information will be posted to the QuestCDN online bid interface under Project Q&A and the City website.

The major items of work include approximately: The project includes, but not limited to, the construction of Dean's Trail from Oriole Street west to Thrush Street, under Highway 412 in a proposed precast concrete box culvert tunnel, then east to Sara Ford Avenue. The Contract consists of 1,738-ft of 12' wide concrete trail, precast concrete box culvert 12-ft x 10-ft tunnel, drainage improvements, and water and sanitary sewer relocations.

An Optional Pre-Bid Conference will be held on 2:00 p.m., TUESDAY, May 18, 2021 via online Zoom meeting. Zoom meeting information will be posted to the QuestCDN online bid interface under Project Q&A and the City website.

Addendums to the bid package will be issued through the online Plan Holders List; therefore, all prime bidders shall be responsible for downloading the bid documents from the online plan room in order to be included in the Plan Holders List. Prime bidders should be registered on the Garver Plan Holders List in order to submit a bid on the project.

For this project, bids will only be accepted through the QuestCDN online electronic bid interface. To access the electronic bid form, download the project documents, refresh the project's page on the online plan room, and then click the "on-line bid" button below the project name.

Each bidder must deposit with his bid, security in the amount, form and subject to the conditions provided in the Information for Bidders.

The successful bidder must furnish a performance and payment bond upon the form provided in the amount of one hundred per cent (100%) of the contract price from an approved surety company holding a permit from the State of Arkansas to act as surety, or other surety or sureties acceptable to the Owner.

Pursuant to Arkansas Code Annotated §22-9-203 The City of Springdale encourages all qualified small, minority and women business enterprises to bid on and receive contracts for goods, services, and construction. Also, City of Springdale encourages all general contractors to subcontract portions of their contract to qualified small, minority and women business enterprises.

A State of Arkansas Contractor's License is not required to bid on the project; however, no contractor shall submit a bid prior to submitting an initial application (which does not require a full audit) for licensure, and no construction contract shall be executed until the successful bidder has furnished an appropriate license

issued by the State of Arkansas Contractor's Licensing Board.

"Buy America" provisions apply to this project. The Arkansas Department of Transportation's Standard Specifications Section 106 has requirements and restrictions for Buy America. Also, 23 CFR § 635.410 has all of the federal requirements for Buy America." This means that any permanent steel in the project must be manufactured in the US."

This Project is a Federal-Aid contract. This project requires wage rates to be paid according to Davis-Bacon Federal Wage Rates.

The City of Springdale hereby notifies all bidders that this contract is subject to applicable labor laws, non-discrimination provisions, wage rate laws and other federal laws including the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938. The Work Hours Act of 1962 and Title VI of the Civil Rights Act of 1964 also apply.

The City of Springdale reserves the right to waive irregularities, reject bids, and postpone the award of any Contract for a period of time which shall not exceed beyond sixty (60) days from the bid opening date.
