IT IS ORDERED that a meeting of the Arkansas State Commission be opened at 10:00 a.m., December 7, 2021.

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Committee has awarded purchases on October 29, November 8, and November 29 in the amounts of \$1,015,164.00, \$2,766,285.80, and \$393,416.92, respectively totaling \$4,174,866.72, and supply and service contracts, in accordance with authority previously conveyed, all of which have been documented by official minutes which are of record in the files of the Commission and Equipment and Procurement Division.

NOW THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the action of the Purchasing Committee be ratified and confirmed in all particulars.

WHEREAS, the Arkansas State Highway Commission (Commission) acquired property known as Tract No. 11R, Job No. R20090, from William C. Gooch, of lawful age and unmarried, by Warrant Deed dated May 30, 1995, and filed of record on June 29, 1995, as Book 656, Page 121, in the Circuit Clerk's office for Jefferson County, Arkansas; and

-1-(Continued) WHEREAS, the property was purchased as a capital asset for the sum of FIFTY and NO/100 DOLLARS (\$50.00) and is not subject to re-acquisition by a prior owner pursuant to Ark. Code Ann § 27-67-322; and

WHEREAS, the District Engineer for District Two has determined that Tract No. 11R is not now, nor in the foreseeable future will be, needed for highway purposes. The property is more particularly described as follows:

Part of the Northeast Quarter of the Southwest Quarter of Section 33, Township 6 South, Range 7 West, Jefferson County, Arkansas, being more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, this property contiguous to U.S. Highway 67 and is now necessary for Job No. CA0604, Main St. – Vandenberg Blvd., and which property the Commission now holds as a capital asset, being in Pulaski County, more fully described as:

Part of Lot 1, Block 2 of the Replat of Oak View Subdivision as recorded in Plat Book 4, Page 320 being part of the Southwest Quarter of the Northeast Quarter of Section 19, Township 3 North, Range 10 West, Pulaski County, Arkansas, more particularly described as follows:

WHEREAS, a thorough bid review and analysis is undertaken by the Department to ensure that only those projects are awarded which are judged to be in the best interests of the State; and

WHEREAS, the right is retained to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, or to advertise for new proposals, also as judged to be in the best public interests of the State; and

WHEREAS, the Commission desires to expedite work on these important projects; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Amendment 42 of the Arkansas Constitution, Section 6, as well as other laws of this State, the Commission has the authority to delegate certain powers to the Director of Highways and Transportation.

NOW THEREFORE, upon the contractors furnishing the necessary performance and payment bonds and submitting all additional information required for the above mentioned projects, the Director is hereby authorized to enter into contracts and supplemental agreements for any projects deemed to be in the best interests of the State.

FURTHERMORE, the Director is authorized to reject any or all proposals, to waive technicalities, and/or to advertise for new proposals whenever deemed to be in the best interests of the State.

Chairman Moore opened the meeting by welcoming those in attendance in-person, as well as those who were watching online. Chairman Moore recognized special guests in attendance.

MOTION

Vice Chairman Alec Farmer moved, Commissioner Philip Taldo seconded, and the motion passed to authorize use of electronic signatures for the December 7, 2021 Minute Orders.

MOTION

Commissioner Philip Taldo moved, Commissioner Marie Holder seconded, and the motion passed to approve the Minutes from the November 3, 2021 Commission Meeting

OTHER DISCUSSION ITEMS

Richard Steiner, Head of Policy and Communications for Gatik presented an update of the fully driverless operations with Walmart in Bentonville, which began in August 2021.

Patrick Patton, Chief Fiscal Officer, provided the October 2021 update on State Highway Revenue. Mr. Patton noted that State Highway Revenues to the Department from traditional sources are up a total of 6.7% (\$9.3 million) in SFY 2022 compared to SFY 2021. Revenue from the Natural Gas Severance Tax is higher this year compared to last year. Total revenues available are 12.2% (\$16.9 million) above last year. Actual State Revenue received is 10.1% (\$14.3 million) above projected (budgeted) revenue for this year. Mr. Patton stated that October revenue from the 0.5% General Sales Tax for the Connecting Arkansas Program was 4.57% higher, (\$896,438) than projected by the Department of Finance and Administration (DF&A) for the month. Year to date actual revenue is above projections by 2.12% (\$1,706,006). Since inception, this revenue source is 1.70%, or \$26.2 million, above DF&A's projections.

Vivien Hoang, Arkansas Division Administrator for the Federal Highway Administration presented an overview of the Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act (IIJA), which was signed by the President on November 15, 2021. The IIJA, also known as the Bipartisan Infrastructure Law (BIL) will fund highway programs for five years (FY 2022 – 2026) and includes \$350.8 billion for formula and discretionary highway programs. The BIL also provides new opportunities for local governments and other non-traditional entities to access new funding. Ms. Hoang noted that the BIL will focus on accelerating project delivery by making some changes in the environmental process and in the utility relocation process. In closing, Ms. Hoang also highlighted changes to the Emergency Relief (ER) Program and the time period in which an ER project eligible for emergency repairs may qualify for 100% federal share.

Director Tudor presented the Commission with a list of upcoming meetings and events that the Director will be attending.

In closing, Director Tudor notified the Commission that the Department was recognized by the American Concrete Pavement Association as the "Silver Winner" for Concrete Pavement Excellence. The award was for Outstanding Design and Construction for the I-630 widening between Baptist Hospital and University Avenue. Manhattan Road and Bridge Company subcontracted with Koss Construction Company to widen approximately 2.16 miles of Interstate 630 from 6 to 8 lanes and to reconstruct 5 bridges along this corridor. This was completed in March 2020 as part of the Connecting Arkansas Program.
