  - o receiving proposals for new specifications products, making recommendations for evaluation of the products,
  - o developing and administering a work plan for analysis, preparing intermediate and final reports,
  - o communicating with the manufacturer/supplier.
- Coordinate Materials Division SiteManager activities.

Possession of a current Arkansas\* license to practice professional engineering. Experience in sampling and testing materials used for highway construction and maintenance, in statistical analysis, evaluation procedures, and report preparation.
