- Approximately one quart of each product submitted will be supplied to the Department along with manufacturer's product and application literature and Safety Data Sheets (SDS).
- The manufacturer will supply information concerning the chemical and physical composition of the product and any restrictions to the storage, handling or use of the product.
- When deemed necessary by the Materials Engineer, random samples will by taken and tested.
- Material failure of project and/or random samples will be considered sufficient reason to discontinue acceptance of a material from a manufacturer, determination of which shall be made by the Materials Engineer.
