


SFY 2024 BUDGETED VS. ACTUAL EXPENSES – By Budget Category






SFY 2024 BUDGETED VS. ACTUAL EXPENSES – By Operational Category









SFY 2023 vs. SFY 2024 ACT 416 ACTUAL REVENUE

■FY 2023 ■FY 2024 (MILLIONS)




SFY 2024 BUDGETED vs. ACT 416 ACTUAL REVENUE

ARDOT Contracting Process INTERSTATE 30 WIDENING - SALINE COUNTY

Design Bid Build – A+C Method – Calendar Day Contract

The process for awarding a bid evaluates the Contractor's price plus the number of days to complete the project.

Risk and Complexity

The Contractor's bid should consider project risk and complexity as conveyed in the project's design plans.

Standard Practice

Since 1993 the responsibility for means and methods to construct a project belongs to the contractor. Along with risk and complexity, the contractor should also consider how he will complete the work when submitting the bid amount and stated delivery time.

ARDOT Specifications State:

The submission of a bid shall be considered prima facie evidence that the bidder has made such examination and is satisfied as to the conditions to be encountered in performing the work and as to the requirements of the plans, specifications, supplemental specifications, special provisions, and contract.

Projects that use federal funds are required to be awarded on the basis of the lowest responsive bid submitted. (See 23 CFR § 635.114.)


