Environmental Documentation for State Funded Projects

The City of Cabot is proposing to extend West Elm Street to connect to South 8th Street, South 6th Street, and South 4th Street. The project is 0.25 mile; an attached map illustrates the project location.

Proposed improvements include two 10' wide paved travel lanes with curb and gutter shoulders, 2' grass berms, and 4' sidewalks. Approximately 1.82 acres of new right of way and 0.61 acre of temporary construction easements will be required for this project. The average right of way width will be 65'.

After appropriate environmental review it has been determined that the subject job will not impact any relocations, wellhead protection areas, cultural resources, or prime farmland. SHPO clearance is attached. Field inspections found no evidence of existing underground storage tanks or hazardous waste deposits.

Construction of this project will be on new location and will install a concrete pipe culvert and a double concrete box culvert in two unnamed tributaries. Impacts are estimated to be less than 0.1 acre per crossing. Construction of this project should be covered under the terms of Nationwide Permit 14 for Linear Transportation Projects as defined in the Federal Register 82 (4): 1860 – 2008.

The official species list obtained through the US Fish and Wildlife Service's (USFWS) Information for Planning and Consultation website lists Eastern Black Rail (Laterallus jamaicensis), Piping Plover (Charadrius melodus), Red Knot

(Calidris canutus rufa), Rabbitsfoot (Theliderma cylindrica) and Scaleshell Mussel (Leptodea leptodon) as species potentially affected by the proposed project. Based on the lack of habitat, distance to known species, and proximity to urban/residential development, it is our determination that the proposed project will have "no effect" on all listed species.


Noise predictions were made for this project using the FHWA Traffic Noise Model Version 2.5. The predicted noise levels are below applicable FHWA noise impact criteria; therefore, no project related noise impacts are anticipated.

The staff of the Arkansas Historic Preservation Program (AHPP) reviewed the Project Identification Form for the above-referenced job. The proposed undertaking entails constructing a two-lane extension from West Elm St. to South 8th St. in Cabot, Lonoke County, Arkansas. Portions of existing city streets will require upgrading. The survey corridor for the field investigation was approximately 25 meters wide and more than 300 meters in length. The ARDOT archeologist excavated six shovel tests that proved negative for cultural materials. Low, wet areas, paved surfaces, and a large area of gravel/dirt fill limited the excavation. There are no known historic properties within or proximal to the survey corridor.

Based on the provided information, the AHPP concurs with the finding of no historic properties affected pursuant to 36 CFR § 800.4(d)(1).

Tribes that have expressed an interest in the area include the Cherokee Nation (Ms. Elizabeth Toombs), the Chickasaw Nation (Ms. Karen Brunso), the Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma (Mr. Daniel Ragle), the Jena Band of Choctaw Indians (Ms. Alina J. Shively), the Muscogee (Creek) Nation (Ms. Corain Lowe-Zepeda), the Osage Nation (Dr. Andrea Hunter), the Quapaw Nation (Mr. Everett Bandy), and the Shawnee Tribe of Oklahoma (Ms. Tonya Tipton). We recommend consultation in accordance with 36 CFR § 800.2(c)(2).

Re-evaluation

An Environmental Document for State Funded Projects was completed for the subject project on June 14, 2019. Due to the time elapsed since the environmental document, a re-evaluation of the proposed impacts is required.

There have been minor changes to the project design since the 2019 environmental document, including the project length, reduced from 0.3 mile to 0.2 mile; the proposed lane widths, increased from 10' to 12'; and the proposed culverts, now triple pipe culverts. An additional 871 square feet of new right of way and an additional 0.3 acre of temporary construction easements would be required for this project. Average proposed right of way width would be 69'.


No additional impacts are anticipated as a result of the design changes. No changes to or additional cultural or natural resources clearances, work, or permits are required.
