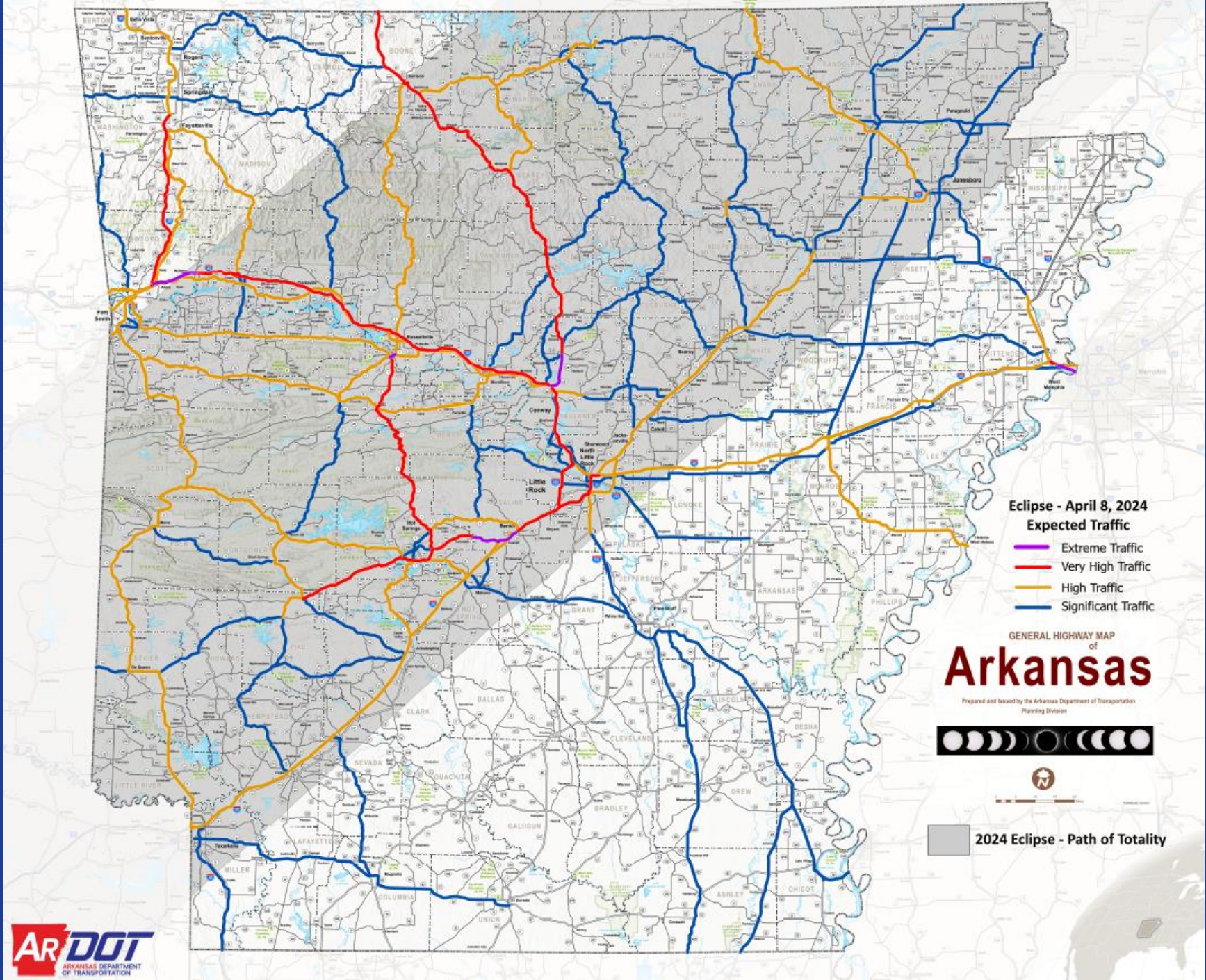

Total Solar Eclipse TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT



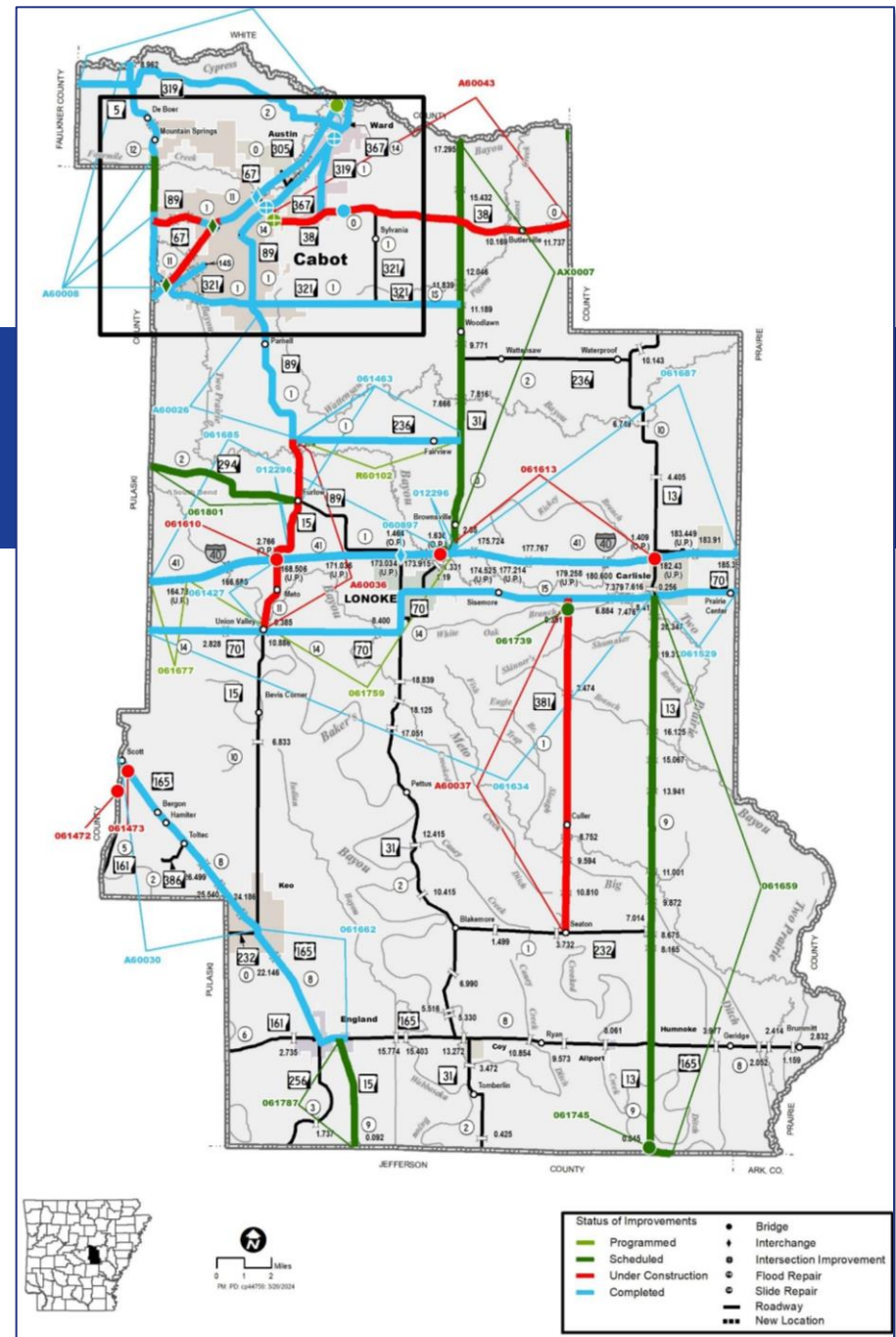

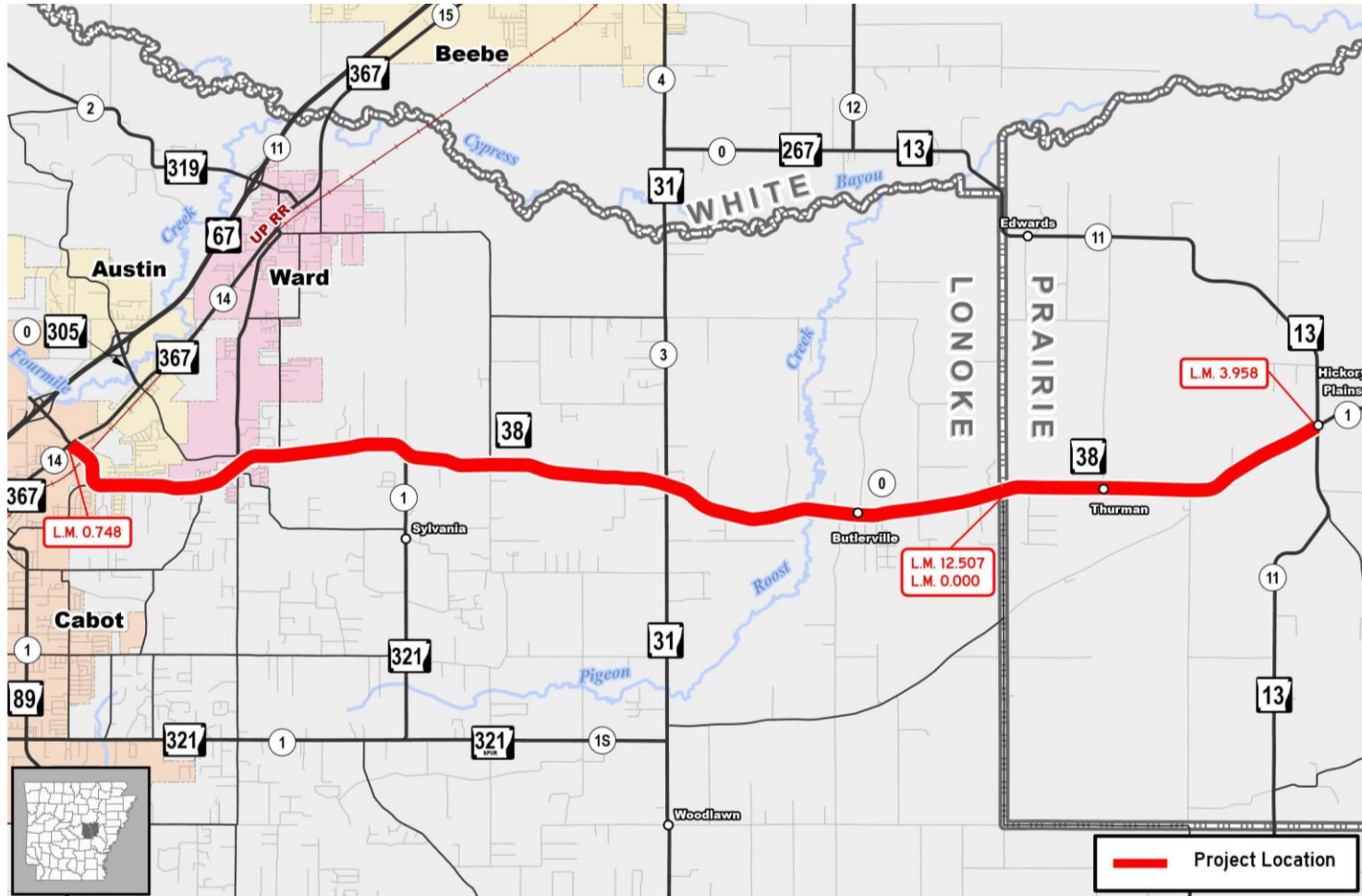

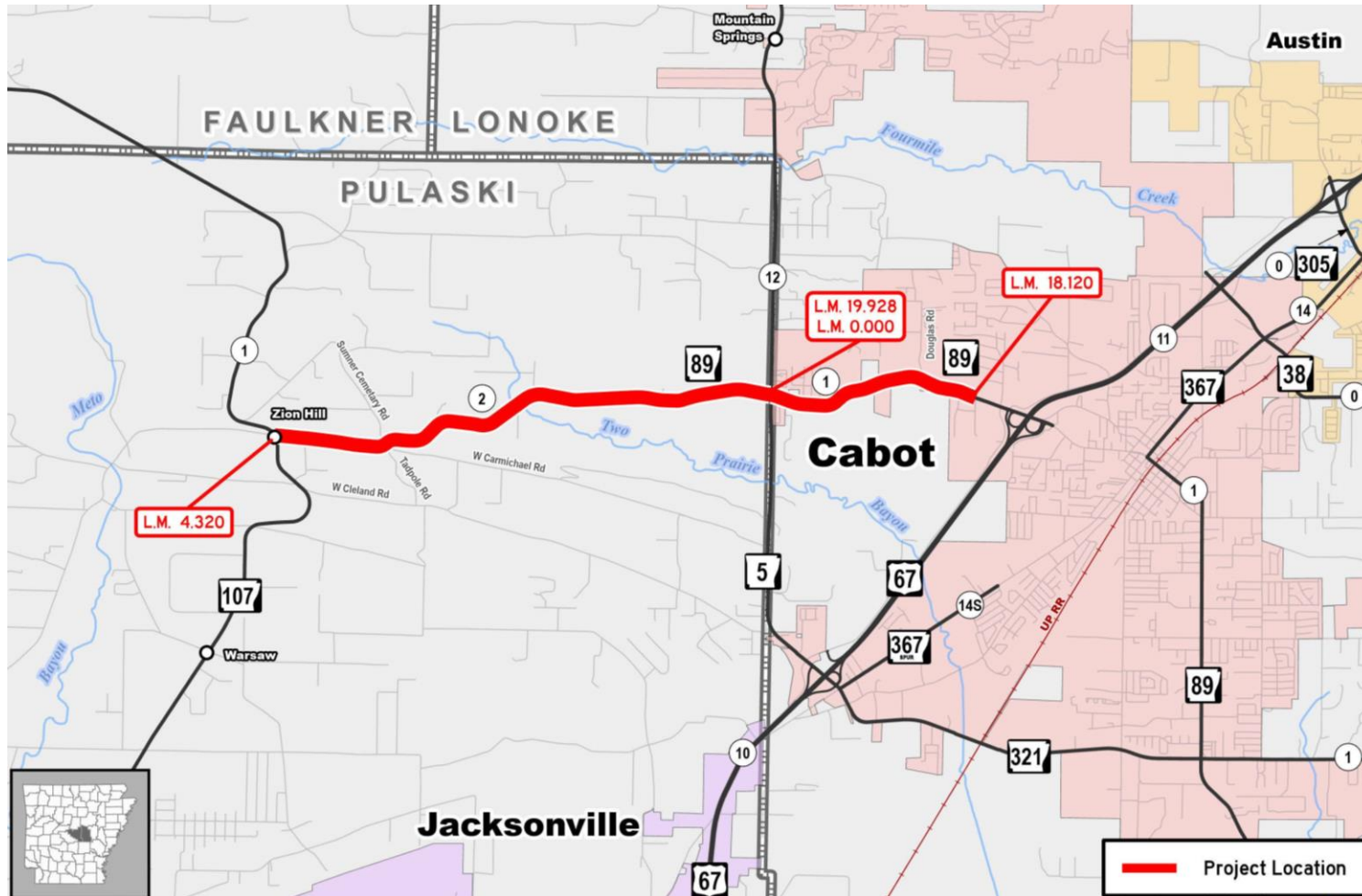
HWY. 367 – HWY. 13 (S)

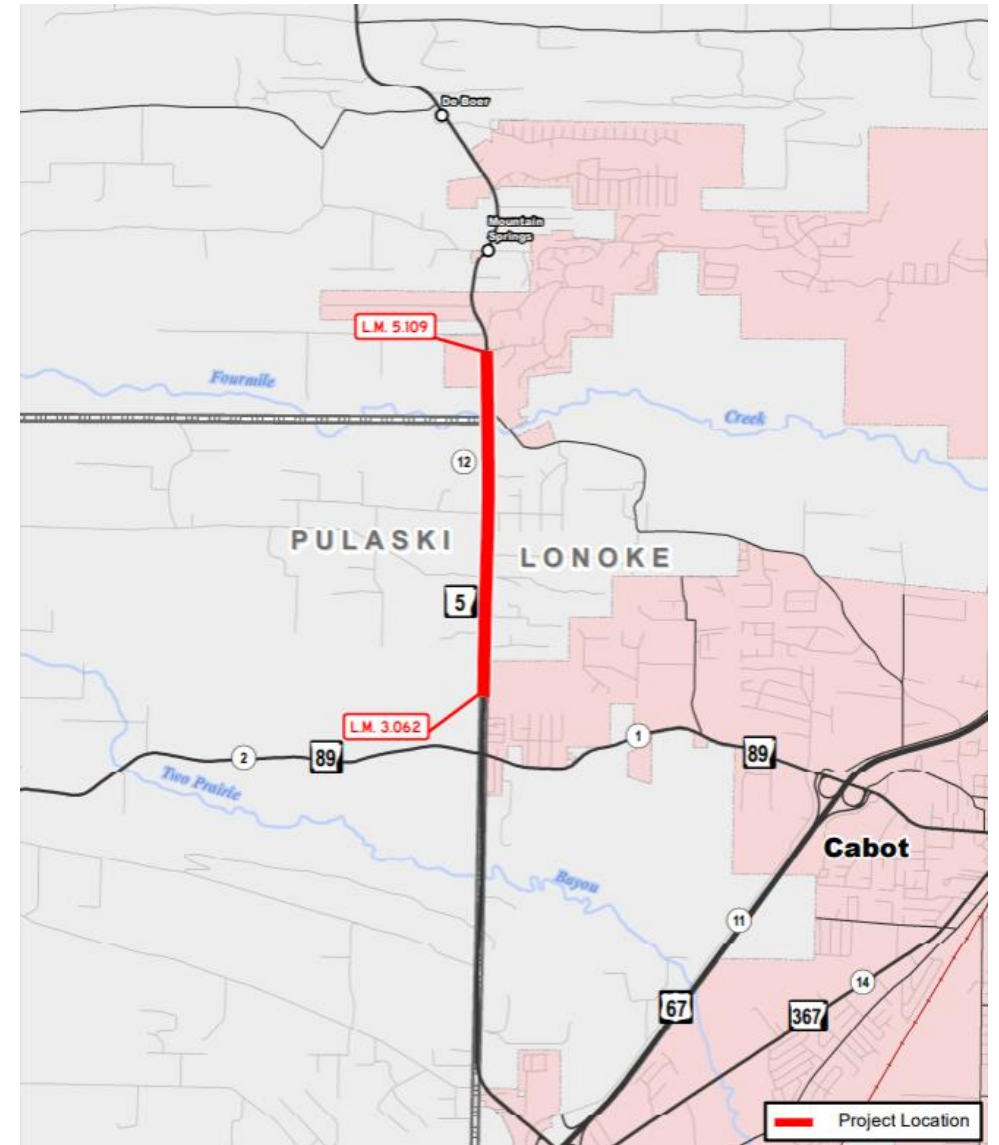

HWY. 89 – GREYSTONE BLVD. (CABOT) (S)

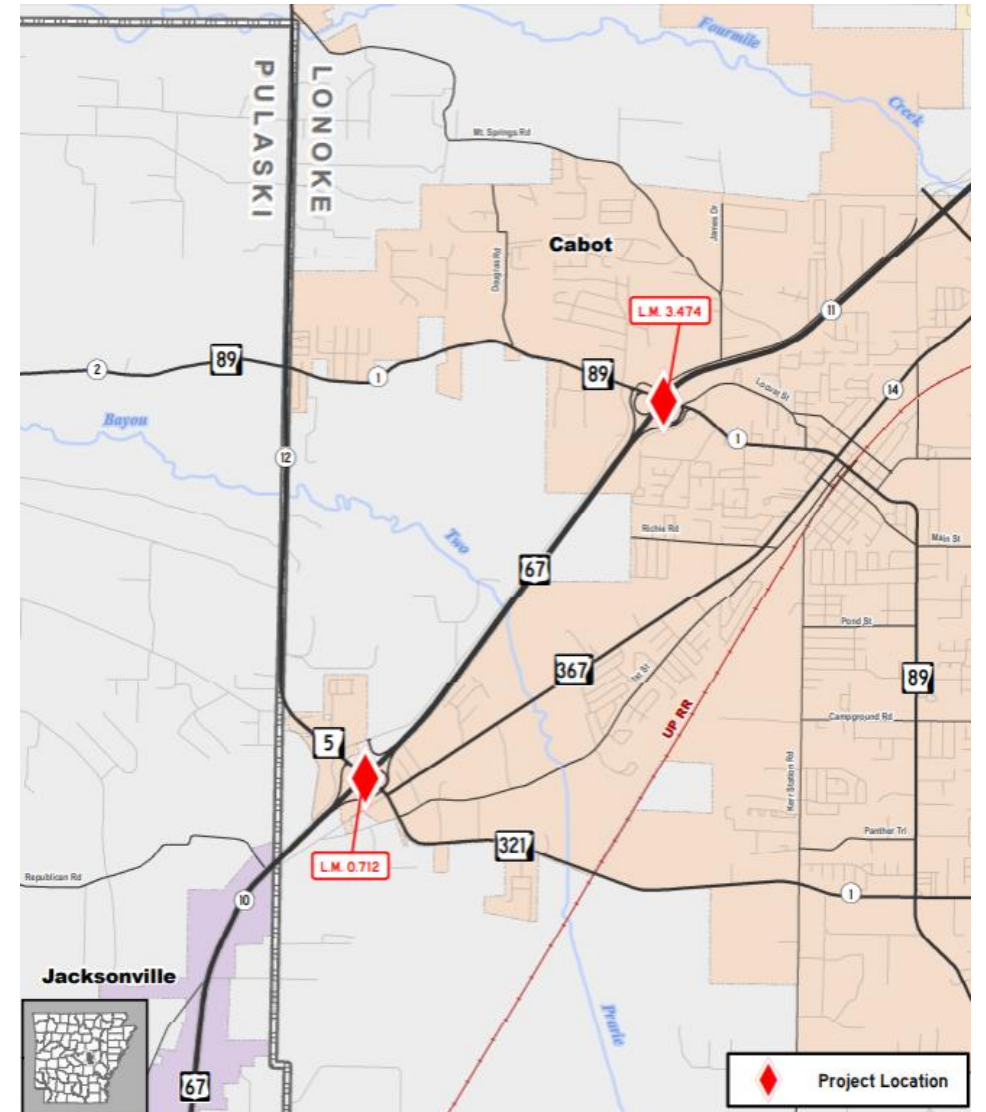
- Widening from 2 to 4 Lanes & Other Improvements

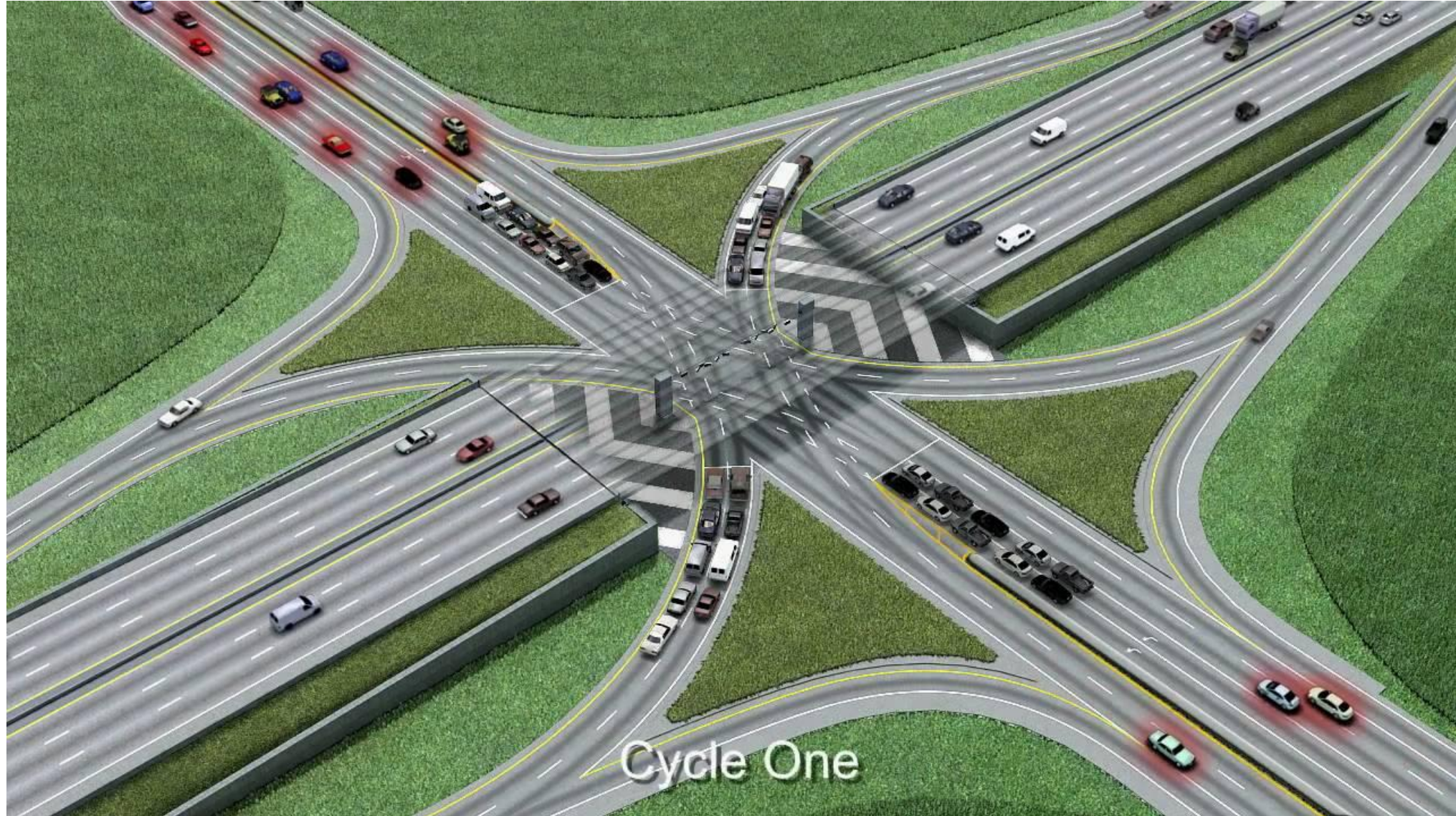

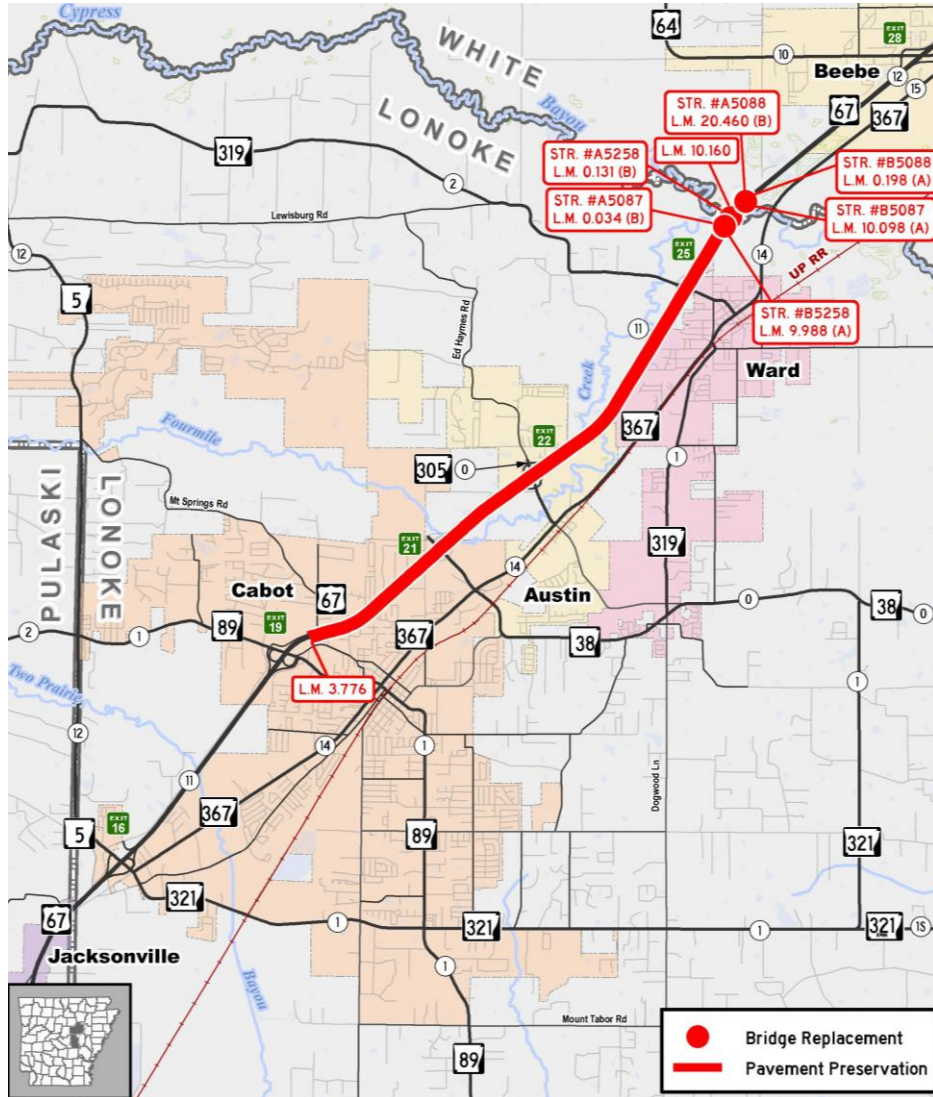
