To submit a donation in Kronos:

- 1. Click "My Information"
- 2. Click "My Requests"
- 3. Select the appropriate pay code for the leave you wish to donate. (You can only donate Annual and Sick leave)
- 4. Donate at least eight hours to be eligible for Catastrophic Leave.

ARKANSAS HIGHWAY POLICE Graduation

The 16th graduating class of certified Arkansas Highway Police (AHP) boasted nine new officers in West Memphis on January 19. The recruits began training in West Memphis on August 15 and completed the first 10 weeks of instruction on October 21; the final 10 weeks of field training wrapped on December 30.

"Today, the Arkansas Highway Police is a nationally recognized leader in the fields of drug interdiction, motor carrier safety, hazardous materials enforcement and training," reported AHP Chief Jeff Holmes. "The professionalism of our officers, combined with the respect of our mission and heritage, help us set the standard in motor carrier safety. I am extremely proud of these brand new officers and look forward to seeing what they do with their careers."

Some of the training included racial and bias policing, law enforcement ethics, Arkansas traffic and criminal law, search and seizure, traffic incident management (TIM), report writing, defensive tactics, firearms, Arkansas size and weight law, CMV Licensing, Arkansas motor fuel tax laws, general hazardous materials, and interpersonal communication. Officers completed practical exercises in size and weight enforcement and conducted numerous mock traffic stops that mirrored real-world scenarios.

Larry Mitchell had the highest average score during firearms qualifications and Michael Sexton had the highest score on a single qualification target.

ARDOT ADOPTS UKG

ARDOT's newest technology system is UKG Pro, a new Human Resources Information System to replace PAHR and the ACE system. You will now have access to your personnel information! Download the UKG Pro (UltiPro) mobile app from the Google Play Store or the Apple App Store and have access to your personnel records any time you need!

- 1. Download the app
- 2. Enter the Company Access Code: ARDOT2022MOBILE
- 3. Select the blue "Use SSO (Corporate Credentials)" button
- 4. Sign in using the same ARDOT email and password you use now to check email.

THINGS YOU CAN DO IN UKG PRO:

- Change your name, address, telephone numbers and emergency contacts.
- View your job title, job description, salary and all your basic personnel information.
- View and update your education, skills, licenses, certifications, awards and relocation preferences.
- Add/change your direct deposit and tax withholding form (W-4).
- View and/or print your pay statements, and send a PDF of your pay statement by email to a lender or other entity quickly and easily from your computer or smart phone.
- View a summary of your state and federal income taxes.
- Model your pay, to see how a promotion or salary change would affect your take-home pay and tax deductions.
- View a summary of your benefits (deferred compensation plan, pension retirement, health insurance, etc.) and update your benefits if you have a qualifying life event.
- View and apply for job vacancies (called "Opportunities" in UKG Pro).
- Register for and attend courses in ArDOT University, and request on-thejob training.



KEY DATES TO REMEMBER:

December 19, 2022 – Employees gain access to UKG Pro from a link on ARDOT's home intranet page.

January 3, 2023 – Employees can view and apply for job vacancies—called "Opportunities"—in UKG Pro. Openings will no longer post in the old system after January 3, 2023.

January 6, 2023 – Employees get direct access to pay statements beginning with the paycheck dated January 6. (You can still access older earnings statements from prior pay periods in from SharePoint.)

End of January 2023 - Employee training records will be fully loaded in the system.

Second quarter and beyond - Some additional features to be implemented in the coming months include performance evaluations, document manager, employee voice, goal-setting and career coaching, conversations and feedback, competencies assigned by job title, and more! \diamondsuit


