ARKANSAS STATEWIDE TRAVEL DEMAND MODEL UPDATE

Notice is hereby given that the Arkansas Department of Transportation (ARDOT) is seeking letters of interest from qualified consulting firms for services to update the Arkansas Statewide Travel Demand Model (AR TDM). ARDOT utilizes the AR TDM for a variety of tasks, including forecasting changes in travel patterns over time; predicting changes in travel patterns resulting from transportation system improvements or natural disasters; estimating system performance measures; and other purposes.

The work will generally consist of updating network layers, demographics, and other base year and forecast year attributes; updating the model architecture, user interface, and reporting tools; and adding new functionality; with the goals of modernizing and improving the calibration and utility of the model.

Interested parties must furnish a one-(1) page cover letter with primary contact information addressed to Jared Wiley, Chief Engineer—Preconstruction, Architect-Engineer Qualifications Standard Form (SF 330) Parts I and II, completed Contract and Grant Disclosure Form (EO 98-04), and a current copy of the firm's equal employment opportunity (EEO) policy as required per Arkansas Code Annotated (Ark. Code Ann.) §19-11-104. Additionally, firms are asked to provide a brief one (1) page summary of the qualifications of proposed project manager(s) and key team members, including the prime and any subconsultants.
