Participation in the ARDOT Association of Retired Employees

Greetings to all ARDOT retirees. The Association of Retired Arkansas Department of Transportation Employees was incorporated on December 10, 1982. The petition for incorporation was presented by Hurley H. Perkins, Ralph B. Jones and E. A. Ashcraft. The first official annual meeting was November 2, 1983. Therefore, we are celebrating the 40th Anniversary of the Association. I do not have a copy of the original By-Laws, but they were last approved, adopted and signed by C. F. Russenberger, President and Bonnie Wesson, Senior Vice President on October 27, 2016.

Membership and participation in the Association allows us to continue the fellowships developed over our years of service. However, there are other reasons for joining and participating. Among them are:

- To stay informed on what is happening at ARDOT. This includes getting updates about retirement benefits, health insurance and financials.
- To promote or oppose legislation which affects retirees. Although the

Address and Beneficiary Changes

Attention all retirees, if you move, please notify RoShunda Watson at the Arkansas State Highway Employees' Retirement System (ASHERS) office at (501) 569-2532. Besides keeping your address and phone number current, you also need to keep your beneficiaries current. You should contact the Group Insurance Office at (501) 569-2417 for beneficiary updates on your life insurance. Since 2001, the Retirement System provides an additional lump-sum benefit of \$7,500 payable to your beneficiary at the retiree's death. If you have any questions about this benefit or the beneficiary for this benefit, please call (501) 569-2532.



Johnnie L. Parks Sr. (1951-2023)

It was with much shock and sadness that we learned of the sudden passing of Johnnie Parks Sr. on June 24, 2023. Johnnie retired in 2008 as the Assistant Chief of Internal Audit. He was the Statewide Senior Vice President of the Association and a frequent participant at the District 6/Central Office Chapter's meetings.

Johnnie was a Deacon/Elder at the Longley Baptist Church and a member of Toastmasters. He was often called on to lead invocations at meetings and his eloquent prayers were appreciated by all. Condolences and prayers for his wife Veolia and the family during this time are appreciated. He will be missed.



ASHERS has provisions that allow an individual to retire by disability. Eligibility for disability retirement requires an employee to be vested, and the disability could not have been incurred prior to becoming a member of the System. To qualify for disability retirement, the health conditions of the applicant must prevent them from performing their assigned duties and must be permanent or of long duration.

To receive a disability annuity, an individual must apply through the Retirement Office. Once an application is received, the Retirement Office will contact the member's doctor(s) for documentation of the disability. Upon receipt, the required documentation is submitted to the ASHERS Medical Disability Board for review. The Board will evaluate to determine if the documentation supports approval for disability retirement. If approved the member will receive a full disability benefit based on the benefit calculation of the high 5- year average salary multiplied by years of service and the System multiplier of 2.2%.

A disability retirant may earn an amount less than what is considered by the Social Security Administration as the maximum amount that a person under sixty-five (65) years of age may earn without losing disability benefits. *Periodically, the System will require those retirants, who retired because of a disability, to submit proof of income.* In some cases, those retirants may be required to undergo a medical examination. If and when a medical examination shows that the disability has been removed, the annuity benefit shall cease until such time as the individual reaches the age and service requirements for service retirement.

If a disability retiree under age 65 secures employment making an amount that exceeds the Social Security Administrations maximum for retirement disability annuities, they must notify the Retirement Office. The retirant is allowed a nine-month trial period to earn compensation from that employment during which time *no monthly benefits from the System will be paid*. At the end of the nine-month trial period should the retirant wish to continue their employment outside the System, then the disability retirement status shall terminate.


